# Elaeagnus x Ebbingei

Ebbing's Silver Berry



**Nitrogen fixer**  
**Fruiting shrub**

## Features:

- Food - Berries fresh or juiced; seeds raw or roasted.
- Horticultural Uses - other than as a nitrogen fixing shrub, this is an evergreen that can be trimmed and trained into hedging (a replacement for juniper and cedar hedging). Blooms late fall with intense beautiful smelling flowers.
- Nitrogen Fixer - good nitrogen fixer
- A cross between *Elaeagnus macrophylla* x *Elaeagnus pungens*
- For best pollination plant with Gilt Edge

## Characteristics:

<b>Size</b>	8'T x 8'W or as pruned	<b>Sun/Shade</b>	full sun to part shade tolerates full shade
<b>Soil</b>	all except wet heavy clay	<b>Pollination</b>	cross pollinates with Autumn Olive, Goumi, & Gilt Edge
<b>Zone</b>	7-9	<b>Water</b>	drought tolerant
<b>Bloom</b>	Late fall	<b>Harvest</b>	May thru June
<b>Decid. /Evrgreen</b>	showy evergreen
