

# Haskap - Honey Berry

*L. caerulea emphylocalyx and kamtschatica*

**Blue Hokkaido** - upright 4-5 ft

**Blue Velvet** – spreading 4 ft tall x 5’ wide

**Blue Mist** – 2-3 ft x 3-4 ft wide

**Blue Pacific** – 2-3 ft tall & wide

**Blue Pagoda** - 2-3ft tall & wide



## Features:

- Food - blue berries in late spring; flavour of haskap has been described as somewhere between a blueberry, a Saskatoon berry and a raspberry.
- Horticultural uses - a early leafing shrub that handles part shade to full sun. The more sun, the more berries, but the earlier the leaf drop (September)
