

# Sea Buckthorn

## Sea Berry

(Hippophe rhamnoides)



### Features:

**Food:** berries for juice or fresh; leaves for tea.

**Nitrogen Fixer:**

#### German Cultivars

Vigorous growth of 8-12 ft, and the juice by itself is good quality. (P2 P3)

- **Askola** – Juice berry - High Vit C and E (mid season, Sept.)
- **Leikora** – fresh eating – very large berries (late, Oct.)
- **Hergo** – Juice berry - (mid season, Aug.)
- **Orange Energy** – Juice berry - high yields, few thorns, (mid season, Sept.)

#### Russian Cultivars

Smaller at 6-8ft, all early season. (P1)

- **Titan** – exception grows to 10 ft, very large flavourful and aromatic fruit
- **Russian Orange** – Attractive with dark orange fruit and slender long foliage – High ornamental value
- **Star of Altai** – sweetest berries; suited for dry conditions
- **Botanica** – Very large bright orange flavourful berries, (mid season, August)
- **Sirola** – sweet and easily picked. (early, July)
