Eleutherococcus senticosus



Features:

- Growth Habit:
 - Grows in clumps along forest edges
 - Erect scarcely branched stems reach 8'-15' tall
 - Beautiful specimen plant
- Medicinal:
 - roots - dried and ground into a powder or made into an infusion. Considered a powerful adaptogen
- Non-Medicinal:
 - Leaves dried and used for tea
 - Lots of research on the web.
